

INSTRUCTIONS for fitting rear carpet and ancillary pieces – 5582 and 5682 Patrician only

Pieces A and B were sewn onto the front carpet, as delivered.

Pieces D and E were sewn onto the rear carpet, C, as delivered.

The pieces above are not sewn onto this replacement carpet because:

- 1- the new carpet is much thicker and denser than the original, and is not bound in most places because it would look strange being so thick. Simply install the front and rear main carpets and then cut to fit pieces A, B, D, E, so that the carpet pieces fit together tightly, then hold in place with carpet tape. If you are careful in cutting the carpet pieces A, B, D and E, you will a seamless "wall-to-wall-carpet" look. The outside edge of A and B fit under the sill plates. The outside edges of the main carpet C, and pieces D and E fit under, partially, the sill plates.
- 2- since the carpet is heavy, it is very hard for me to fit all of the pieces together perfectly without the benefit of being able to fit them into each customer's car
